General Rules And Regulations

- i. Registration for the events is through online basis.
- ii. Registration can be performed by team captains and staff coordinators only.
- iii. Registration shall not be entertained after the dead line date (depends on the events), mentioned in the website.
- iv. Maximum number of participants from each year for solo events is,
 - On stage events – 4 participants.
 - Off stage events – 4 participants.
- v. Maximum number of groups from each year for group events is,
 - On stage events – 2 groups
 - Off stage events – 2 groups
- vi. Maximum number of events allowed for a single participant is limited to
 - On stage solo events – 3 events
 - Off stage solo events – 3 events
 - Group events – No limit.
- vii. Point for each event will be awarded as follows

	First	Second	Third
Solo Events	5	3	1
Group Events	10	6	3

- viii. Organizing committee will strictly stick on to the scheduled time of events.
- ix. Violation of rules listed out for the events will lead to disqualification.
- X. Judges' decision will be final. Clarifications regarding the judgment will not be entertained.

Rules For OffStage Events

Water colour, Pencil drawing, Poster Making

- Maximum time 2 hours.
- Drawing sheet will be provided.
- Participant should bring pencil, brushes, colors..etc

Cartoon, Caricature

- Maximum time 1 hour.
- Contestants can use pencil, sketch pens, ball pens for drawing.
- Drawing sheet will be provided.

Spot Sketching

- A team should contain three members.
- First member of the team should draw the given picture in one minute.
- Second member should draw the sketch drawn by the first member in one minute.
- Third member should draw the sketch drawn by the second member in one minute.
- The given picture and the sketch drawn by the third member will be compared for deciding the winner.

Essay Writing , Poem Writing, Story Writing -- Malayalam, English

- Maximum time will be 1 hour.
- No reference material will be permitted during the competition.
- The language of the competition shall be strictly used.

Cine Quiz

- A team shall consist of two members.
- Quiz will be based on both national and international movies.

Debate - English, Malayalam

- A team must consist of 2 members.
- Topic is given on the spot.

Rules For Open Space Events

Mehandi Design

- A team should contain two members.
- Maximum time 2 hour.
- Mehandi will be provided by organizing committee.
- Decoration of both hands are mandatory

Collage

- Team shall consist of two members.
- Theme for collage shall be given on the spot.
- Time limit for collage making shall be 1½ hour.
- Only chart papers will be provided from Institute, All other material must be brought by the participants. Paper, Magazines, Glue, Scissors, Pencil to be brought by participants.

Vegetable carving

- The vegetable carving team can consist of a maximum 2 members.
- We request the participants to bring all the necessary materials, including vegetables for the competition.
- Total time is 90 minutes (In addition to this 15 minutes will be given for cleaning and winding up.).
- All participants should be able to justify the appropriateness of the title.
- No scraping or carving vegetables is allowed before the start of the event.
- Carving will be done only during the hour assigned.
- Each team will be assigned a seating area.

- All categories of vegetables and fruits can be used.
- Participants should bring their own carving tools and a cutting board.
- Use of leaves, real flowers, live animals or any other decorative element or to make advertising designs on the sculpture is prohibited.
- Use of electric instruments is prohibited as well.

Face painting

- It is a team event. There can be only 2 participants in a team.
- Participants should bring their own colors (fabric paints), brushes etc.
- Time limit is 60 minutes.
- Topic will be given on the spot.
- Participants will be judged on the basis of creativity, innovation and design.

Photography

- Item will be conducted on the spot.
- The time limit will be 2.30 hours.
- Participants can use either DIGITAL or FILM ROLL Camera.
- Mobile Phone Cameras will not be allowed.
- Each participant should submit only one photograph taken by him/her based on the theme/topic.
- Photographs will be judged on the basis of content, composition, sensitivity, creativity and style.
- Only Colour photographs can be submitted for valuation.
- The entries should be in original and must not be modified/edited in any manner.

- The Camera along with Memory Card / Film Roll should be submitted to the Stage Manager for verification / formatting before the commencement of the competition.
- Digital cameras of up to 30 Megapixel can be used for the competition. (In case of cameras with higher Megapixels, the entries must be within the 12 Megapixel size.)
- In case of digital photographs, the format of the entries should be capable of being transferred to a computer without any compatibility problems.
- Further instructions if any will be announced at the time of competition.

Rules For OnStage Events

Karaoke Song

- Time limit for Solo Song with Karaoke is 8 minutes.
- Karaoke is to be presented in a CD or USB stick with the particular Karaoke only and submitted to the stage manager prior to the competition.
- Organizers are not responsible for the malfunctioning of the CD or USB stick.
- Language of the song should be Hindi or Tamil or Malayalam.
- Participants may sing any kind of songs (Songs from Films, Albums etc.)
- All music must be in the original song format; personal or professional remixes (mash-ups) are not permitted.

Lite Music

- Time limit for Light Solo Song is 5 minutes.
- Only Malayalam language is to be used for this competition.
- Track music and background music are not allowed.
- Film songs are not encouraged.
- Classical numbers like "Varnam" and "Keerthanam" are also not encouraged.
- Participants are not allowed to refer to any notes or printed materials during the presentation.

Poem Recitation- English, Malayalam

- Each contestant will be given a maximum of 5 minutes to recite the poem.

- Participants are not allowed to refer to any notes or printed materials during the presentation.
- Film songs are not encouraged.

Elocution (Malayalam/English)

- Maximum time allotted for the item is 5 minutes.
- The topic will be given 10 minutes before the start of the competition.
- The language of the competition shall strictly be used.
- Reading of the speech is not permitted; but the participant may refer to written points for the speech.

Mappilapattu

- Time limit for Mappilapattu Song is 5 minutes.
- Film & album songs are not encouraged.

Mimicry

- Each participant shall be given 5 minutes.
- Judgment will be based on imitating skill, variety of sound and voices imitated and overall presentation.
- No vulgar or unparliamentary language will be entertainment.
- The decision of the judge will be final

Mono Act

- Time allowed is 5 minutes.
- Judgment will be based on qualities like ability to act, clarity of language, literary expression, originality, humor, general impression etc.

Fancy Dress

- Participants can choose desired costumes or characters.
- Participant should adhere to a maximum time limit of 2 minutes
- Only solo performance is allowed.
- Participants will be judged according to character portrayed, creativity and presentation skills.
- Background music is allowed.

Nadan Paattu

- The group can consist of all boys or girls or combined with a maximum of 8 participants and minimum of 5.
- Film songs are not allowed for competition, Only non-film folk songs can be presented.
- The team must present folk songs in Malayalam.
- Time allowed is 10 minutes.
- Instruments are allowed.

Movie Spoof

- Maximum number of ten participants are allowed.
- Maximum time allotted is 15 minutes.
- Use of make-up, drapery and background music is allowed.
- Personal remarks, Character assassination etc. are not allowed.
- The Item will be judged basically on qualities like theme , work on acting, stage craft, total design and general impression.

Oppana, Vattapaattu

- Separate competitions will be held for oppana- male (Vattapaattu) and oppana-female.
- Maximum number of participants is 10.
- External help(singing) is not allowed for Vattapaattu.
- Other rules are same as that of group dance.
- Maximum time allotted is 10 minutes.

Mime

- Mime or Mookabhinayam is acting without words.
- It is an art which expresses through gestures, postures and Facial expressions. It portrays ideas, themes or tells a story, through physical movements only.
- Maximum No. of 6 participants are allowed, accompanists allowed are 2.
- Maximum time allotted for the item is eight (8) minutes.
- Judgment will most likely be based on qualities like idea, creativity of presentation, use of make-up, costume, music and general impression.

Cinematic Dance

- Dance music is to be presented in a CD or USB stick and submitted to the stage manager prior to the competition.
- Organizers are not responsible for the malfunctioning of the CD or USB stick.
- Any Language of dance music can be used. Group can use fusion songs also

- There is no restriction for seeking external help for the background music.
- The participating team will be responsible for removal of the sets, properties etc immediately after the completion of the performance.
- Judgment based on rhythm, formation , expression, costumes, makeup, co-ordination and overall effects.
- Maximum number of participant is 10 and not less than 4.
- Maximum time allotted for stage setting is 3 minutes and performance is 10 minutes.

Spot Dance

- This round will be an Adapt tune round. The song will be given to the participant on the spot.
- The maximum time allowed per participant is three minutes.
- Three different tunes or songs will be given to the participant on the spot.
- The participant should have to dance according to the changes in tune.
- One song will last for one minute.

Step in Synchro

- Maximum number of participant is 4.
- There will be a separating screen.
- Judgment will be based on rhythm formation, expression, costumes and synchronization.
- Maximum time allotted is ten minutes.
- Stage settings are not allotted.

Bharathanatyam

- Each participant will be allowed up to 15 minutes including time for preparation, exit etc.
- Maximum four accompanists are permissible.
- CD or USB is permitted for playing the background score.

Thiruvathira

- There is no restriction in seeking external help for back ground music.
- Maximum number of participants is 8.
- Maximum time allotted is 10 minutes.
- Thiruvathira song is to be presented in a CD or USB stick and submitted to the stage manager prior to the competition.

Nostalgia

- Songs used should be from films released before 1999.
- Maximum number of participants is limited to 6.
- Maximum time allotted is ten minutes.
- There is restriction for seeking external help.
- The participating team will be responsible for the removal of their sets, properties etc immediately after the completion of performance.
- Judgment based on rhythm, formation , expression, costumes, makeup, co-ordination and overall effects.

Margamkali

- Competition will be held only for girls.
- Maximum number of participants is 7 including a singer.
- Time allowed is 10 minutes.
- 6 members can participate in the dancing. A maximum of 2 members can sing alongside (Total a maximum of 8 people).

- Singing should be accompanied by Ilathaalam.
- Traditional christian dress pattern (Chattayum Mundum) should be used.
- The outfit should be in the traditional Margamkali style.
- Judgment will be based on the basis of rhythm, formation, expression, costume, makeup, sets and overall effect.

Desk knock

- Time limit is 5 minutes.
- Maximum number of participants is limited to 3 in numbers.

Mr. & Ms. Xtasy

- Maximum number of participants are 4 per year (2 Boys & 2 Girls)
- Competition will have various rounds to test a participant on Spontaneity, presence of mind, attitude, guts, general awareness etc.
- There will be elimination in each round.

Tik-Tok Mania

- The theme will be announced few days in prior.
- Maximum video length should not exceed 30 seconds.
- All videos should be sent to the year captains, out of which 10 videos are to be selected by him/her.
- Further procedure will be informed soon.
